FAQs & How to Participate

Q: I've purchased a Ticket Package. Now what can I expect? A: Thank you! If you chose to receive tangible benefits, those items will be delivered the week of the event to the local address you provided. Everything else is online, so you can participate solo, with family or friends, and from near or far. We encourage you to share about our event with others, bid on auction items, purchase raffle tickets, play the wine and jewelry pull and tune in for our video program on February 12 at 6:30 PM. Like and share our social media content, and above all, feel great knowing you're making it possible for children who struggle with social and emotional learning to overcome their challenges by receiving the intervention and support they need. All content will be shown on www.theharrisschool.org and links to it will be available on facebook and Instagram leading up to the event, so be sure to check for fresh information online in the coming months and weeks.

Q: What should I do for the night of the event? A: One way to celebrate is to host a watch party. Not sure who or how many to invite? We suggest you review your area's local department of health and CDC guidelines before making any plans. Safety first! Then, 1.) Ask guests to mark their calendars for February 12. 2.) At 6:30 PM, head to www.theharrisschool.org and from the homepage, click on Share the Love to be taken to the event page. Our clickable video will appear at the top of the page. 3.) Encourage guests to pre-register to bid on the auction and to purchase tickets for the raffle and wine/jewelry pulls. We wouldn't want them to miss out on the fun and the chance to win some great prizes! Charitable contributions are encouraged should they feel inspired to do so. It's a fundraiser, after all! Any size gift matters and will make a difference.
